MEDICAL MARIJUANA ZONING AMENDMENT

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of Mayfield to define and regulate medical marijuana facilities.

THE TOWNSHIP OF MAYFIELD ORDAINS:

Mayfield Township Zoning Ordinance No. 100 is hereby amended to add a Section 1529 as follows:

Section 1529. MEDICAL MARIJUANA FACILITIES.

All medical marijuana facilities shall comply with the following requirements:

1. Any medical marijuana facility shall be in continual compliance with all state laws pertaining to the growing, possession, use or distribution of medical marijuana and shall be in continual compliance with the Mayfield Township Medical Marijuana Ordinance.
2. A medical marijuana facility shall only be allowed to operate in a single-family dwelling which is occupied as a residence by a caregiver. No medical marijuana facility shall be allowed to operate in any office building, commercial building, industrial building, apartment building or residential apartment.
3. No more than one (1) caregiver shall operate out of any medical marijuana facility location.
4. Any medical marijuana facility shall be at least 1000 feet from any state licensed daycare facilities, pre-schools, primary schools or secondary schools and at least 500 feet from any church.

Mayfield Township Zoning Ordinance No. 100 is hereby further amended to add the following definition:

Section 201. *Medical Marijuana Facility.* A facility where a “primary caregiver” grows, cultivates, stores, dispenses or offers medical marijuana for sale to “qualifying patients” under the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act of 2008. The

terms “primary caregiver,” “qualifying patient” and “marijuana” shall have the meanings prescribed to them in the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act of 2008.
