MAYFIELD TOWNSHIP ELECTRONIC BOARD MEETING April 12, 2021

The regular electronic meeting of the Mayfield Township Board was called to order at the Mayfield Township Hall, at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America, by Superior Daniel J. Engelman.

Supervisor Daniel J. Engelman read aloud: DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY

As of April 8, 202 the State of Michigan has had 723,297 confirmed Covid-19 cases, 16,400 deaths, and a positivity rate of over 18% due to Covid-19. As of that same date, Lapeer County has had 7,184 confirm/probable cases, 143 deaths and a fatality rate of 2.3%. New and unexpected challenges continue to arise and threaten the population in Mayfield Township including the presence of Covid-19 variants. The Township must take all necessary precautions to protect residents and staff against Covid-19.

Therefore, as Mayfield Township Supervisor, in accordance with MCL 30.410(1)(b), I hereby declare a local state of emergency as of April 12, 2021. Furthermore I authorize the Lapeer County emergency management coordinator to act as the Township's emergency response administrator. The emergency response administrator shall institute policies necessary to conduct the essential mission and functions of the Township under all threats and conditions with the intent of promoting the safety and welfare of both Township residents and staff.
