The regular meeting of the Mayfield Township Board was called to order at the Mayfield Township Hall, at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America, by Supervisor Daniel J. Engelman.

Motion by Knowlton, seconded by Frisch, **PASSED**, to waive the reading of the minutes of the July 8, 2024 regular meeting, and approve them. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Schlaud, seconded by Kile, **PASSED**, to approve the Treasurer report for June and July, as presented. All ayes. Carried.

Public Time: County Commissioner Brad Haggadone discussed the County Commission race, discussion on signs, policy, GLTA.

Motion by Schlaud, seconded by Frisch, **PASSED**, to approve the agreement between Lapeer Co. Road Commission and Mayfield Township P# 504-014-244309, on Coulter Road, in the amount of \$9,400. As presented. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Frisch, seconded by Knowlton, **PASSED**, to adopt the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, Michigan Vehicle Code Act 300 of the 1949, Section 257.627 (9) establishes the "general speed limit" of a county road to be fifty-five (55-mph)miles per hour; and

WHEREAS, A FIFTY-FIVE (55-mph) miles per hour speed limit on Plum Creek Road from Valentine Road easterly to Lapeer Road (M-24), 1.10 miles in total length, is believed to be a hazardous to pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, Michigan Vehicle Code Act 300 of 1949, Section 257,627 (2)(j) states that the County Road Commission may establish a statutory speed limit not exceeding forty-five (45-mph) miles per hour based on vehicular access points;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayfield Township Board supports a forty-five (45-mph) miles per hour speed zone along Plum Creek Road from Valentine Road easterly to Lapeer Road (M-24).

Roll call vote: Kile-aye, Knowlton-aye, Frisch-aye, Engelman-aye, Schlaud-aye. Carried

Motion by Knowlton, seconded by Schlaud, **PASSED**, to adopt a resolution to discontinue any and all activities related to Lapeer Aviation Incorporated, also known as LAI, as of September 12, 2024, this is to also include the Lapeer Aviation flight school training #4401. Roll call vote: Knowlton-aye, Frisch-aye, Engelman-aye, Schlaud-aye, Kile-aye. Carried.
