The regular meeting of the Mayfield Township Board was called to order at the Mayfield Township Hall, at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States of America, by Supervisor Daniel J. Engelman.

Motion by Frisch, seconded by Knowlton, **PASSED**, to accept the bid for Election Equipment, for new Tabulators and accessories, as presented, in the amount of \$27,143.00. Roll Call Vote: Kile-aye, Schlaud-aye, Engelman-aye, Frisch-aye, Knowlton-aye. Carried.
