The regular meeting of the Mayfield Township Board was called to order at the Mayfield Township Hall, at 5:30 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States, by Supervisor Terry D. Jostock.

Motion by Knowlton, seconded by Engelman, **PASSED**, to waive the reading of the minutes of the August 8, 2016 regular meeting and August 30, 2016 special meeting, and approve them. All ayes. Carried.

Motion by Engelman, seconded by Schlaud, **PASSED**, to accept the July and August Treasurer's report as presented. All ayes. Carried. (Copy attached).

County Commissioner Dyle Henning and Lenny Schneider spoke to the board on the county budget, building improvements, millage for veterans and EMS, animal control, community corrections, no jail work crew, CMH becoming an independent entity from the county. House hold waste notification.

Detroit water contract was tabled until the supervisor checked into the fees.

Dave Richardson introduced himself to the board as a candidate running as a right in for circuit court judge.

Motion by Knowlton, seconded by Frisch, **PASSED**, to approve the road project #489-014-164305 for 50 ton of limestone, in the amount of \$1,970.91. All ayes. Carried.

Sexton Steve Nirhans spoke to the board about trees that need to be replaced in section D.

It was the consensus of the board to replace them with a heartier tree. There are 11 trees in question. A proposal will be submitted.
